Lilac background: Deadkeys

D1 = Main JaghbUni deadkey. Press this and following letter to produce additional characters, such as:

c (č), s (š), z (ž), y (ÿ), r (ý), o (ď), p (b), also a further loose diacritcs: v : line above.

D2 = Hausa-Fulani deadkey (not Bairuni / KoufrUni, but other Unicode fonts, k (ḳ), b (ḅ), d (ḍ)).
