D1 = Main JaghbUni deadkey. Press this and following letter to produce additional characters, such as: d (ḏ), t (ṭ), k (ḵ) c (č), s (š), z (ž), y (ÿ), r (ý), o (ǫ), p (ḡ), also a further loose diacritics: v : line above, u : line below, H : two dots below, h : curve below, g : caron.

D2 = Hausa-Fulani deadkey (not Bairuni / KoufrUni, but other Unicode fonts, k (ḵ), b (ḡ), d (ḏ)).
