Lilac background: Deadkeys

D1 = Main JaghbUni deadkey. Press this and following letter to produce additional characters, such as:

e (ē), g (ğ), d (ḑ), t (ṭ) c (č), s (š), z (ž), y (ȳ), r (ȳ), o (ð), p (p), also a further loose diacritcs: n: dot under, m: dot above, u : line under, h : curve under, H = two dots under, a = acute, q = grave.

D2 = Hausa-Fulani deadkey (not Bairuni / KoufrUni, but other Unicode fonts, k (k̂), b (b̂), d (d̂).
